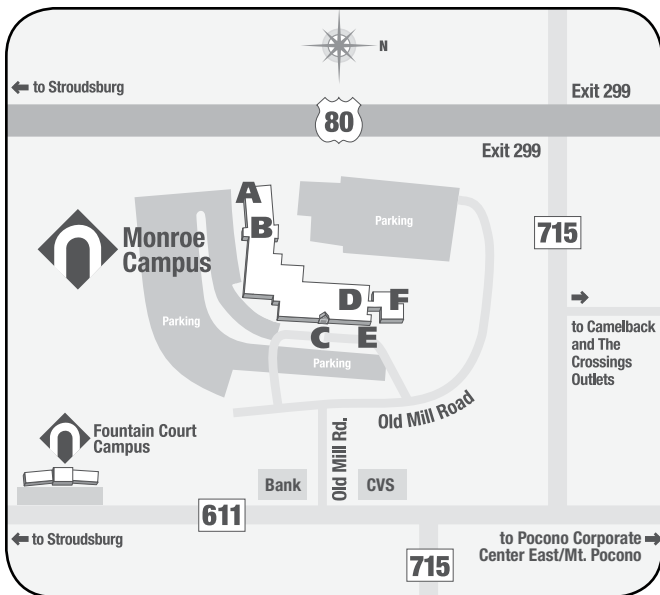

### Directions to Pocono Corporate Center East (map not shown):

**From Route 80:** Take Route 380 North to Pocono Route 940 exit #3. Turn right at top of ramp. Follow Route 940 to fifth traffic light and turn left heading North on Route 611. Follow Route 611 for 1.5 miles and turn right onto Corporate Center Drive East and follow the road until it ends. 1900 Corporate Center is the first building on right. (map not shown)

## HOW TO REGISTER

You may register for non-credit, community education courses in one of five convenient ways:

**In-person registration** is available during normal office hours in the Records Office at the Monroe Campus, Tannersville.

**Mail-in registration**, complete the form on page 2 and mail, with your payment, to the Records Office.

**Telephone registration**, you may register by telephone and charge it to your MasterCard, Visa, AmEx or Discover credit card. Simply dial toll-free 1-877-543-0998, between 8 AM & 7 PM, Mon-Thurs; between 8 AM & 4:30 PM, Friday. The college is closed Fridays from mid-May to mid-August. You should have at hand your credit card and all the information requested on the mail-in registration form.

### Directions to Monroe Campus

**From the East:** Take Route 80 west to exit 299, Tannersville. Take a right off the exit onto Route 715 north. Go to the stoplight at Route 611 (about 1/2 mile) and take a right on Route 611 south. Go 3/10ths of a mile, and take the first right turn (Old Mill Road) between CVS and PNC Bank. Go to the end of Old Mill Road and take a right, then the first left.

**From the West:** Take 80 east to exit 299, Tannersville. Take a right off the exit and follow the directions from the east.

**From the Lehigh Valley:** Take Route 33 north to Route 80 west. The road splits to become Route 33 and Route 209. Stay on Route 33. Take 80 west to exit 299, Tannersville. Take a right off the exit and follow directions from the east.

**Special Note:** The Monroe Campuses of Northampton Community College are serviced by MCTA (Monroe County Transportation Authority). For bus schedule information, please call MCTA at 570-424-9500 or pick up a schedule at the Monroe Campus Lobby in Tannersville.

### Directions to the Fountain Court Campus from Monroe Campus

Take Old Mill Road to Route 611. Make a right onto Route 611. Go about 2 miles. Look for Fountain Court Mall on right hand side. NCC Fountain Court offices located on first and second floor.

**FAX registration**, you may also register by faxing your registration form to 610-861-5551.

### Fee Refunds

Enrollees who withdraw from a course, workshop, or seminar one working day prior to the first session will receive a full refund of course fees. 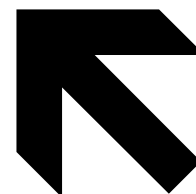

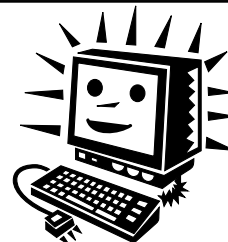
### \* Women and Investing

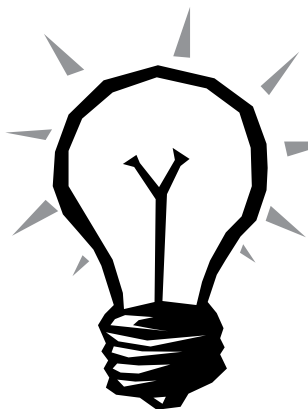

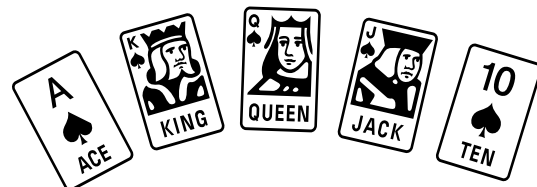

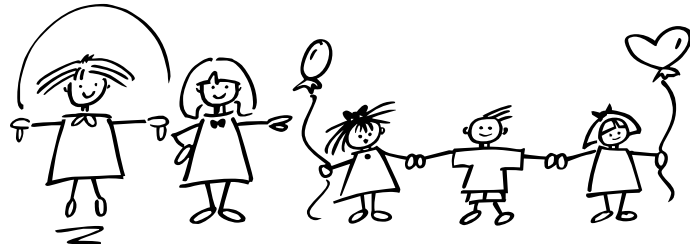
