Place: Bethlehem Campus, College Center, 220

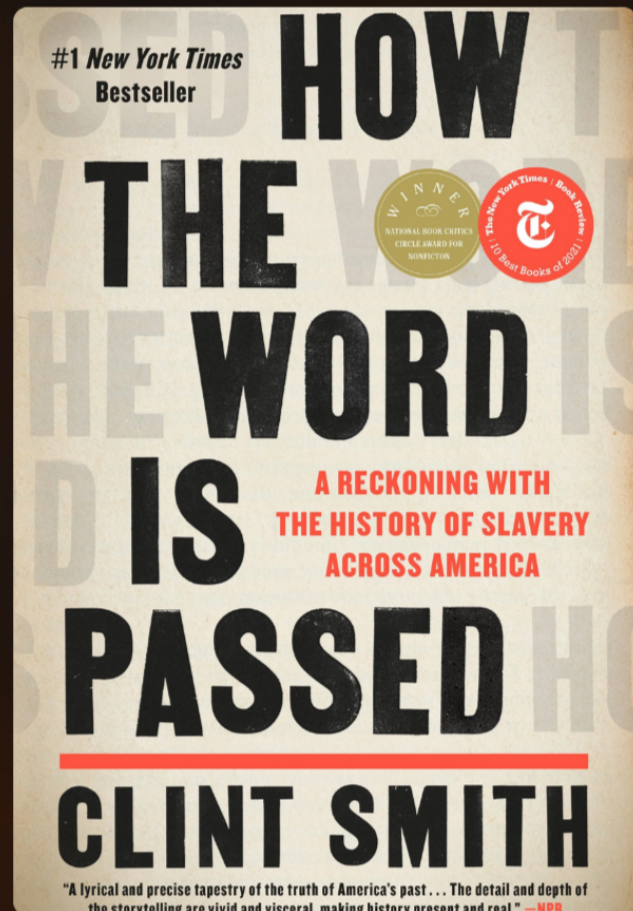
Event Itinerary:
