### NEW IN JEWELRY ARTS!

The NCC Jewelry Arts Program recently acquired a new 10-ton hydraulic press, and you can now learn all about hydraulic forming for jewelry making. Our new class offerings will cover the types of jewelry you can make, the use of different types of shaping and forming dies, and the various techniques employed to create some amazing jewelry.

An introduction to hydraulic die forming is now included as part of our Basics and Soldering classes. NCC is building an inventory of impression dies, some of which were made from the original hand-carved hub (hob) masterpieces from as early as the mid-1800's. Our new class offerings will also include using traditional hand tool techniques with these same impression dies.

We will now offer Open Studio (OS) enrollments for the Basics and Soldering classes at NCC. This will provide interested students more consistent access to our impression dies and hydraulic press, as well as to our facility and instructor.

Students without their own tools will no longer be required to rent the basic toolkit from Gilman's. These kits will now be provided to every student at no charge at the beginning of each class.

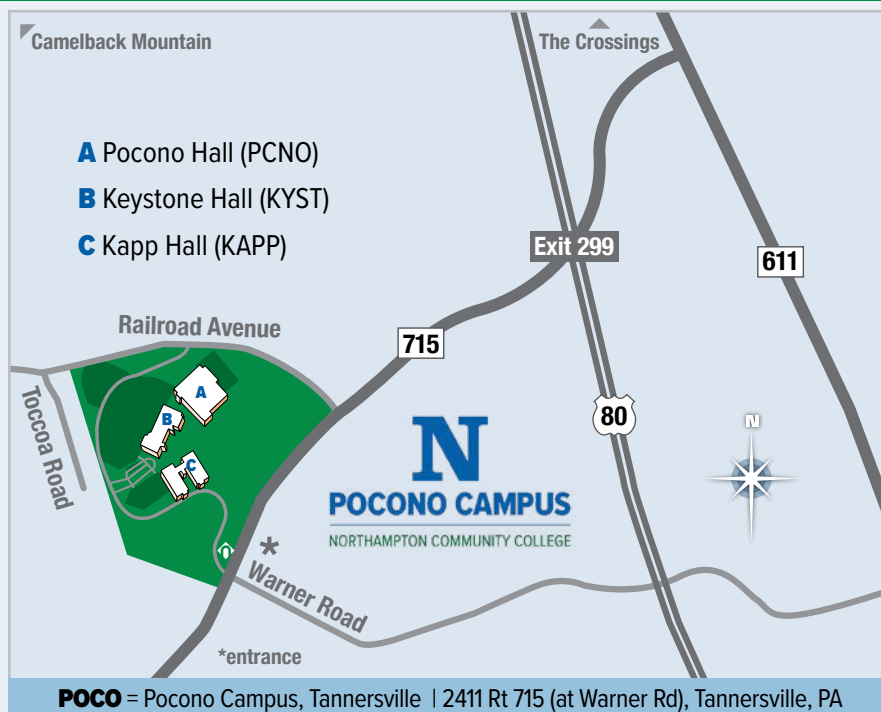

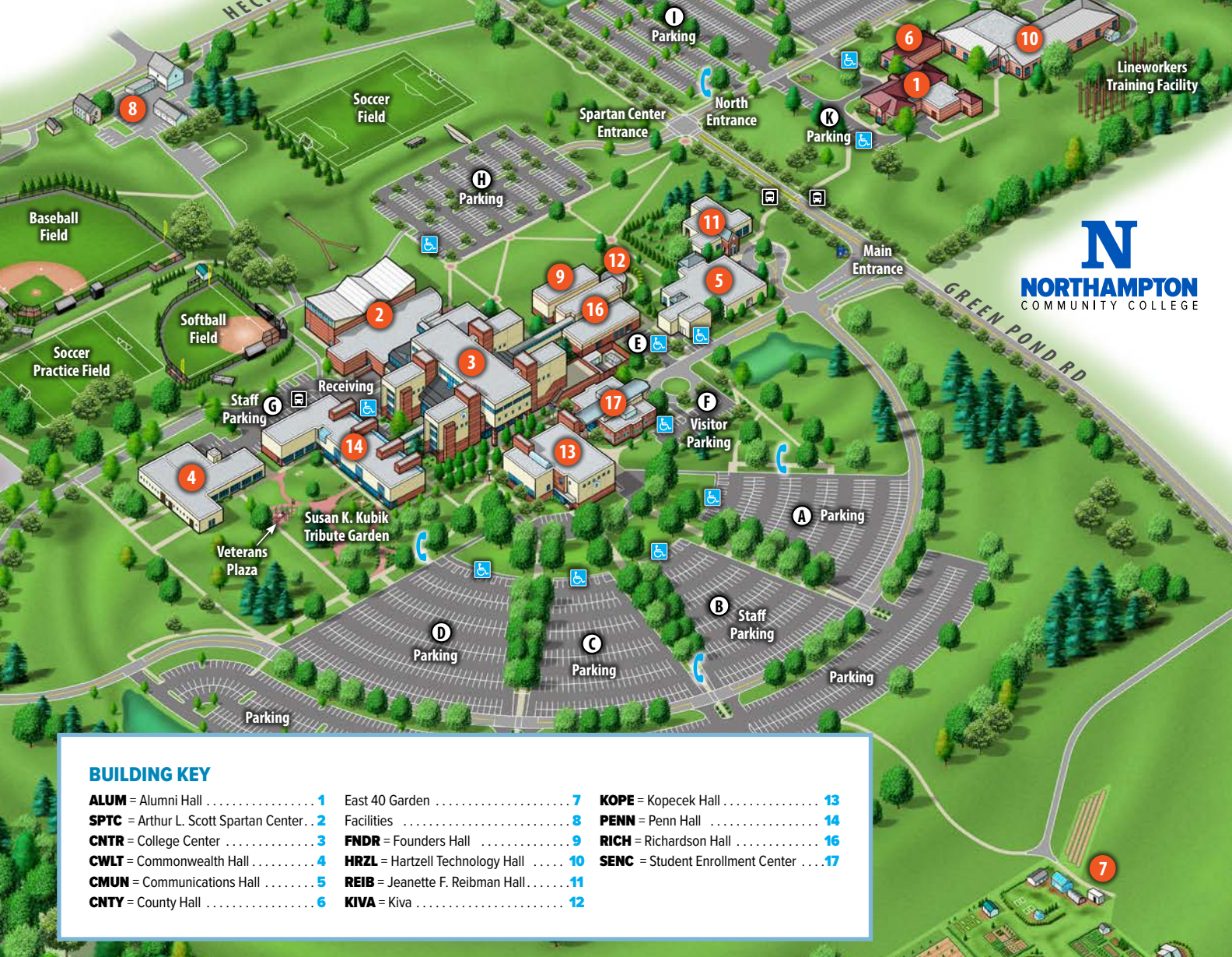

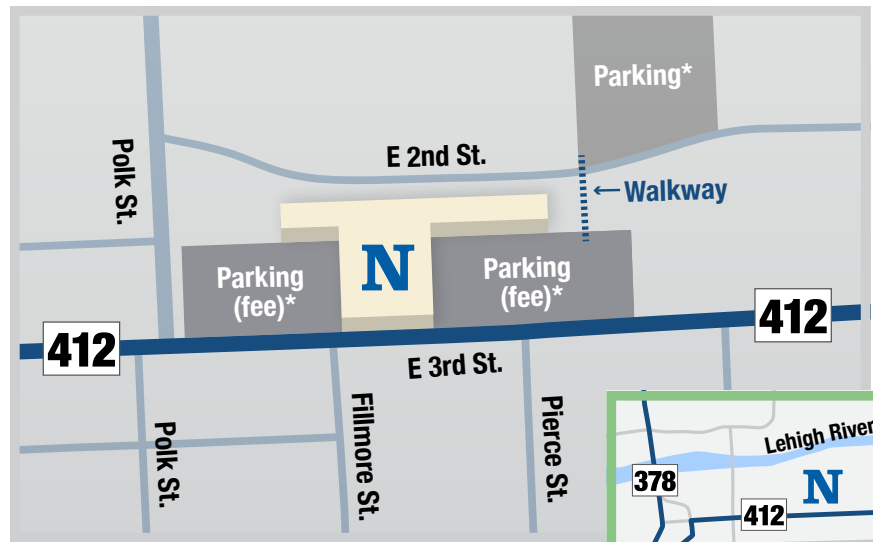
