Program Notes:

In Semester 4, PSCO 270 or PSCO 280 can be taken to complete the degree. PSCO 280- To obtain instructor approval to register, students must complete internship requirements.

Electives can be any course except: OXX-level courses & EARL 221 & 222. SPED160 Introduction to Special Education and SPED175 Behavior Support are suggested electives for students planning to work in a school setting.

**Writing Intensive course options: BIOS 105G, SOCA 103G, SOCA 125G, PSYC 103G, PSYC 258G are recommended; or any 100- or 200- Elective (e.g. PSYC258G- WI ends in "G")

Writing Intensive course codes end in G. Example: PSYC103G is writing intensive; PSYC103 is not. Please pay attention to the option you select. For example, if you are looking for an SSHB writing intensive course, look for one that ends in G via the SSHB course tag.
