In order to earn the Proficiency in English as a Second Language Specialized Diploma, students must pass the following courses with a B- (80%) or better: ESLL131, ESLL133, ESLL137, ESLL138.

The Proficiency in English as a Second Language Specialized Diploma is intended to provide students who speak a native language other than English the necessary language competency to succeed in typical college and career settings. It enhances students' employability and bolsters their career opportunities by providing students the requisite English skills to succeed in an increasingly English-dominant world.
