- Must be at least 18 years of age and possess a High School Diploma or GED

- Pennsylvania Child Abuse History clearance
- Immunizations/titers - Mantoux (TB) (series of two) and Hepatitis B Immunization (series of three)
- BLS for Healthcare Providers (due prior to externship)
