- Completed 2 residential façade improvements
- Started the Tenant Advocacy and Landlord/Tenant Mediation program










- Connected over 128 Bethlehem residents to community resources
- Engaged 111 south Bethlehem residents in neighborhood meetings
- Engaged 1,000+ residents at 8 community building events
- Served over 200 youth through activities at the Lynfield Community Center, Shooting Stars Basketball, Touchstone Summer Programming Scholarships, Hispanic Center Lehigh Valley Intergenerational programming, and Push Ahead Lehigh Valley




- Supported the growth of 3 community gardens in south Bethlehem
- Engaged 98 residents through gardening and outdoor wellness activities
- Held 9 neighborhood cleanups that engaged 80 residents and business owners
- Supported the Kellyn Foundation's ongoing produce distribution on the Greenway
- Installed a mural on the South Bethlehem
 Greenway in partnership with two local artists and
 Donegan Elementary School
- Supported the ongoing work of the Southside Ambassadors in the Four Blocks International area

Beyond the Southside:

- Supported the Alley House Program's community engagement work in West Bethlehem
- Provided leadership training and community engagement support to the Pembroke Choice Community Ambassador team
- Completed three façade improvements in the Northside Alive neighborhood





COMING SOON!

- Affordable rental housing project to create five new units, in collaboration with the Cathedral Church of the Nativity, the City of Bethlehem, and New Bethany.
- Sidewalk and Tree Mini-grants continue to support local residents, businesses or nonprofits in the Indian Hill neighborhood to tackle minor sidewalk repairs, and street tree planting or removal.
