<u>NCC Child Care Scholarships</u> – Eligibility: NCC students who meet academic achievement requirements and have financial need. Go to <a href="https://www.northampton.edu/cost-and-financial-aid/scholarships">https://www.northampton.edu/cost-and-financial-aid/scholarships</a>.

<u>KEYS - Keystone Education Yields Success</u> - Eligibility: NCC students who receive TANF (cash assistance) and/or SNAP (food stamps). Students must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to be considered. <u>Child Care Aware of America (CCAoA)</u>: Provides fee assistance for eligible active-duty, Guard, and Reserve service members who use community-based care.

<u>Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN)</u>: Helps cover the cost of high-quality civilian childcare for families who cannot access an installation-based childcare program.

<u>State and Local Veteran Grants:</u> Many states, including Pennsylvania, offer veteran-specific childcare subsidies or funding through their Department of Human Services or local veteran service offices.

<u>Post-9/11 GI Bill Stipends & VA Programs</u>: Some veterans using education benefits may qualify for additional support for dependents, including childcare assistance. (VA CCSP)
