



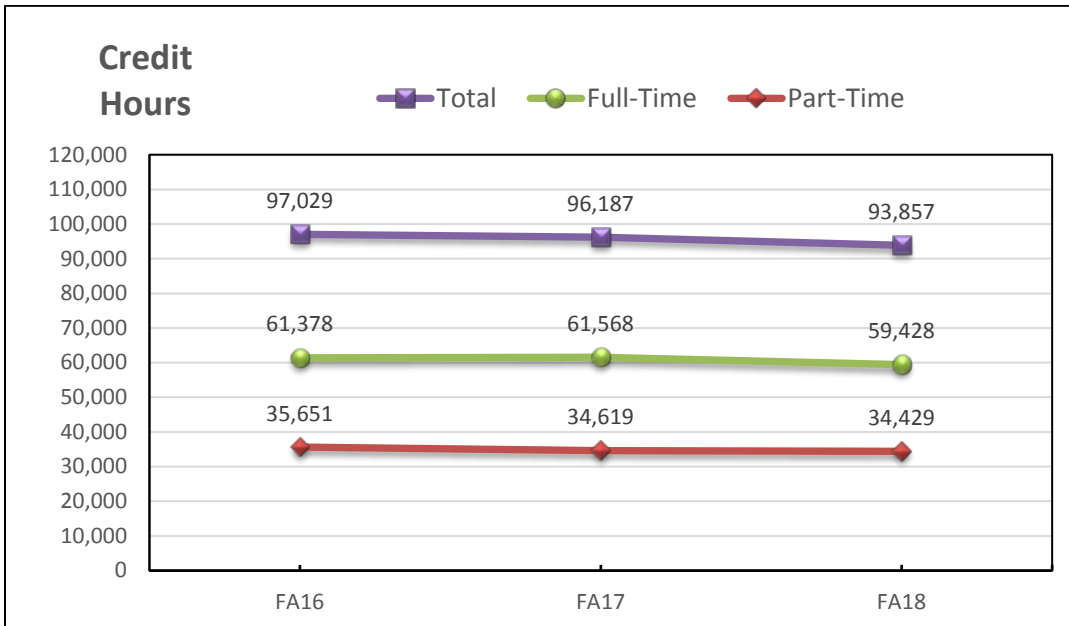
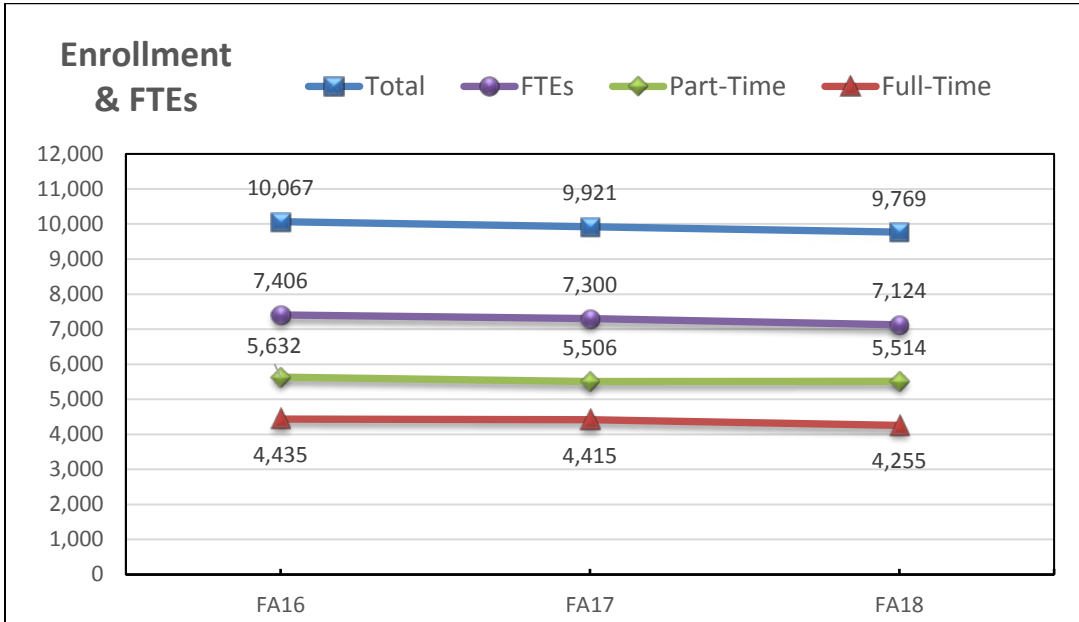

CREDIT ENROLLMENT TRENDS

Fall 2018 Census

October 2018



Credit Enrollment Trends Fall 2018 Census

- * The number of credit students enrolled in Fall 2018 total 9,769 representing a decrease of 152 students, or 1.5%, over Fall 2017. FTEs total 7,124; a 2.4% decrease over last fall. Credit hours total 93,857; also a 2.4% decrease over last fall. This is the seventh consecutive year of declining fall enrollment.
- * The number of full-time credit hours decreased, by 3.5% to 59,428, after increasing last fall, while the number of part-time credit hours continued to decrease, by 0.5% to 34,429 over last fall. Full-time credit hours represent 63% of the total credit hours, down from 64% last fall.
- * The number of full-time students continued to decrease, by 3.6% to 4,255, while the number of part-time students increased by eight students to 5,514, after decreasing last fall. Full-time students represent 44% of the total credit enrollment, down from 45% last fall.
- * The number of female students increased by 0.9% to 5,971, after decreasing last fall, while the number of male students continued to decrease, by 5.1% to 3,798. Female students represent 61% of the total credit enrollment, up from 60% last fall.
- * The number of new students decreased by seven students to 3,450, after increasing last fall; the number of continuing students continued to decrease, by 2.9% to 5,043; while the number of reentry students increased by six students to 1,276, after decreasing last fall. New students represent 35% of the total credit enrollment, the same as last fall.
- * The number of students transferring into the College increased by 2.1% to 3,380, after decreasing fall, while those transferring in with a degree decreased from 846 to 796, after increasing last fall.
- * The total number of minority students enrolled continued to increase, by 0.6% to 4,038. Minority students represent 41% of the total credit enrollment, up from 40% last fall.
- * Average age remained at 25, and the median age remained at 21. The number of students < 18 years old increased by 140 or 28.7% to 628, and those aged 25-34 increased by 82 or 4.5% to 1,902, while all other age ranges decreased over last fall.
- * The number of students enrolled from the sponsoring school districts increased by 13 students to 5,517 after decreasing last fall, while the number of FTEs continued to decrease, by 0.7% to 3,872.1 over last fall. Residents enrolled from sponsoring school districts represent 56% of the total credit enrollment, up from 55% last fall.
- * Residents enrolled from Monroe County total 2,363, a decrease of 166 students, or 6.6%, over last fall. FTEs from Monroe County also decreased, by 7.4% to 1,788.0 over last fall. Residents enrolled from Monroe County represent 24% of the total credit enrollment, down from 25% last fall.
- * Total enrollment at the Monroe Campus is 1,853, a decrease of 154 students or 7.7% over last fall. FTEs at the branch also decreased, by 8.5% to 1,217.3 over last fall.
- * Total enrollment at the Fowler Family Southside Center is 120; a decrease of four students or 3.2% over last fall.
- * Students are enrolled from 50 counties outside Northampton County with the highest numbers enrolling from Monroe, Lehigh, Pike, Philadelphia, and Berks counties respectively, 21 states outside Pennsylvania, and 44 countries outside the United States.
- * Fifty-four percent of students are enrolled in transfer programs, 37% are in enrolled in career programs, and 8% are enrolled in other, which includes Guest/Visiting Student, at 179 (down from 231), and High School Dual/Concurrent Enrollment, at 625 (up from 483).
- * Some programs with notable enrollment increases over last fall are:
 - ⇒ Nursing (RN) (+27), continued to increase, by 16% to 192
 - ⇒ Secondary Education (+19), continued to increase, by 27% to 90
 - ⇒ Automotive Technology (+16), up 19% to 99, after decreasing last fall
 - ⇒ Business Management (+13), up 4% to 319, after decreasing last fall
 - ⇒ Fine Art (+13), up 14% to 104, after decreasing last fall
 - ⇒ General Studies (+11), up 0.4% to 2,769, after decreasing last fall
 - ⇒ Computer Aided Design (+10), up 33% to 40, after decreasing last fall

Some programs with notable enrollment decreases: Biological Science decreased by 76 or 21% to 290 and Criminal Justice decreased by 43 or 8% to 472, after both had increased last fall; Liberal Arts continued to decrease, by 39 or 8% to 441; Communication Design decreased by 38 or 22% to 132 after increasing last fall; Accounting and Computer Information Technology both continued to decrease, by 37 or 23% to 125 and by 16 or 7% to 222 respectively; Early Childhood Education: Infant to Grade 4 decreased by 12 or 3% to 429 after increasing last fall; Social Work continued to decrease, by 11 or 6% to 169; and Electromechanical Tech Automated Systems decreased by 10 or 16% to 52, after increasing last fall.

- * FTEs decreased in Allied Health & Sciences by 5.4% to 799.7, and in Education & Academic Success by 1.2% to 372.3, after both had increased last fall, while continuing to decrease in both Business & Technology, by 2.6% to 2,182.8, and in Humanities & Social Sciences, by 2.4% to 3,508.8, over last fall.
