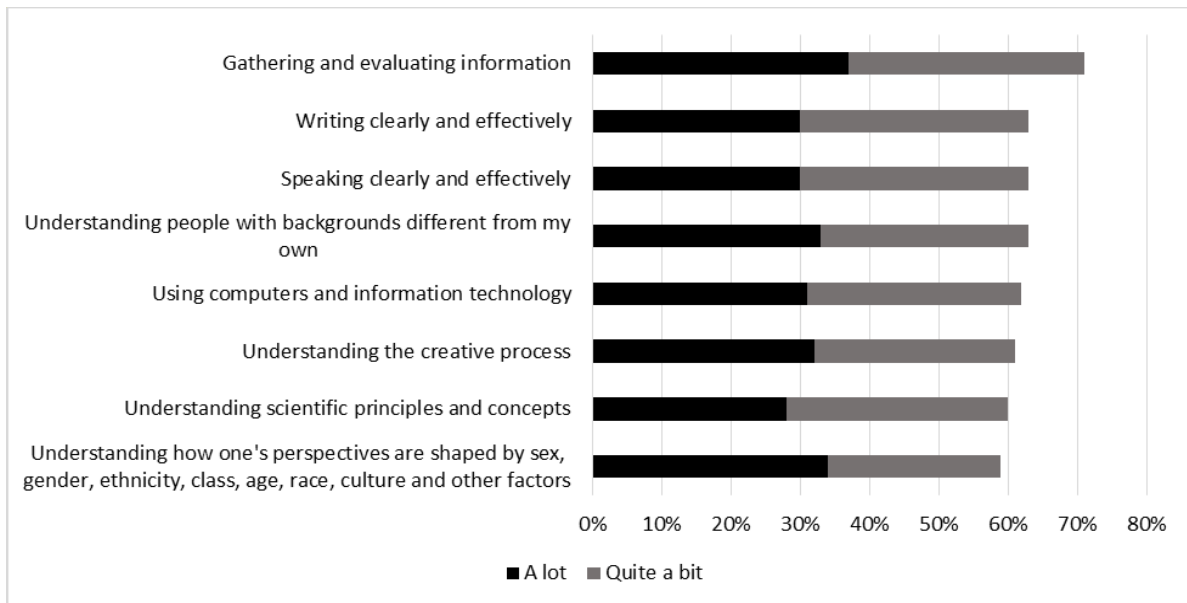


Graduate Outcomes

- ◆ Overwhelmingly, 100% of NCC’s Class of 2013 and 2014 reports that they accomplished their educational objectives at Northampton – 85% fully, 15% partly
- ◆ 99% of those who are continuing their education indicated that NCC prepared them either ‘exceptionally well,’ ‘more than adequately’ or ‘adequately’
- ◆ 94% of those who are working say NCC prepared them either ‘exceptionally well,’ ‘more than adequately’ or ‘adequately’ for their occupation
- ◆ Of those who were working, 27% indicated that they felt underemployed
- ◆ 80% reported that 75% or more of their credits were accepted at their new educational institution
- ◆ 38% say that if NCC were not available, they would not have been able to continue their education
- ◆ 97% rate the quality of their learning experience as ‘good’ or ‘excellent’
- ◆ 99% would recommend NCC to others
- ◆ As shown in the chart below, 60% or more of graduates feel that NCC contributed ‘a lot’ or ‘quite a bit’ to their growth in gathering and evaluating information, writing clearly and effectively, speaking clearly and effectively, understanding people with backgrounds different from my own, using computers and information technology, understanding the creative process, and understanding scientific principles and concepts.
