



IN-PERSON

- Formerly known at NCC as On-Site
- 100% on-campus, face to face
- This is the most traditional course format in which students attend classes on campus during the scheduled class time
- Students may need to access online materials through Blackboard - this depends on the course and instructor
- Exams may be on-campus during scheduled class times or proctored online



ONLINE

- 100% online
- There are no scheduled class meetings to attend
- Students complete all of their course work online through Blackboard
- Participation in regular online instructional activities is required
- Weekly deadlines for work set by the instructor - students move at their own pace during the week to meet these deadlines
- Students may be required to complete online proctored exams/assignments



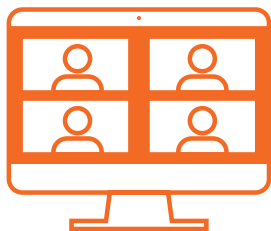
BLENDED

- Formerly known at NCC as Online Blended
- 100% online
- Students meet online one day per week using a video conferencing platform (like Zoom or Blackboard Collaborate Ultra) during the scheduled class time
- Students engage in other required course activities and assignments online through Blackboard - meeting deadlines set by the instructor
- Students may be required to complete online proctored exams/assignments



HYBRID

- 50% on-campus, face to face and 50% online (a mix of the in-person and online course formats)
- Students come to campus at least one day per week for their in-person, face to face class during the scheduled class time
- Students engage in other required course activities and assignments online through Blackboard - meeting deadlines set by the instructor
 - Some hybrid sections will have a required online class meeting (one day per week) where the class will meet using a video conferencing platform (like Zoom or Blackboard Collaborate Ultra)
- Exams may be on-campus during scheduled class times or proctored online



OTHER DISTANCE MODE

- Formerly known at NCC as Remote
- 100% online
- Courses in this format meet online using a video conferencing platform (like Zoom or Blackboard Collaborate Ultra) during the scheduled class time
- Additional course activities and assignments will be available online through Blackboard
- Students may be required to complete online proctored exams/assignments
