In this course students will spend two weeks in Akashi, in Western Japan. Students will work in one of 3-4 student media teams, collaborating on creating a story on a specific topic. We will be based in Akashi and will visit Kyoto, Kobe, Hiroshima, and surrounding areas. This class does not travel to Tokyo.

Course Description

New Media Production in Japan brings students to the city of Akashi in Hyogo prefecture in western Japan. Students will join a four-person student media team. Each team will cover a specific story or topic and will shoot video, edit, do voice-overs, conduct interviews, live vlog, and blog. This is an intense team-based and project based course that will allow students an opportunity to hone their media and communication skills while in Japan. Based out of Akashi, students will have the opportunity to explore much of western Japan including Kyoto, Kobe, Osaka, Hiroshima and surrounding areas. This program does not travel to Tokyo. This course will be capped at 12 students—submit your application soon!

Program fee: \$3800

Refund Schedule

If you withdraw from the program:

- Before February 01, 5:00 PM: Full refund.
- After February 01, 5:00 PM but before February 25, 5:00 PM: Deposit not refundable. Remainder of program fee refundable. Tuition fully refundable.
- After February 25, 5:00 PM but before March 22, 5:00 PM: 50% program fee refundable. Tuition fully refundable.
- After March 22, 5:00 PM: No refund of program fee. Tuition refunded according to Academic Calendar.
