This program brings students to the heart of contemporary and historical Egypt. Beginning in Cairo, you will explore the city, tour the National Museum, and dine aboard a Nile River cruise. Students will travel to Ghiza where they will explore the Great Pyramids and visit the iconic Sphinx. In Cairo students will explore the contrast between the history in the Old City and contemporary Egypt. You will travel to Alexandria where you will visit the famed El-Montazah Gardens and tour the catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa.
