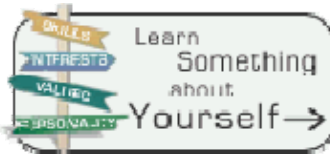

Revisit FOCUS-2 Anytime

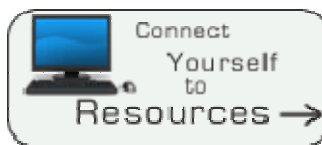
