



Housing is available for Summer Session 1, Summer Session 2, and the Mid-Summer terms.

APPLY TODAY ONLINE VIA THE HOUSING PORTAL!

Eligibility:

- *Students must apply and complete an application for each summer term they are registered for and plan to reside on campus.*
- *Students must be registered for at least one (1) course per summer term in order to be eligible to live in the Residence Hall Commons over the summer. Occupancy will commence and terminate according to the summer session(s) for which you are registered.*

Summer Housing:

Summer Housing will only be offered in the Residence Hall Commons, 1100's wing. Students can choose to have a single room or a double room with a roommate.

Summer Housing Costs:

- Rates depending on the length of your summer term and room type
 - Single Room Rate for 6-Week Term: \$1218.00/session (Summer Session 1, Summer Session 2)
 - Double Room Rate for 6-Week Term: \$1044.00/session (Summer Session 1, Summer Session 2)
 - Single Room Rate for 10-Week Term: \$2030.00/term (Mid-Summer Term)
 - Double Room Rate for 10-Week Term: \$1740.00/term (Mid-Summer Term)

Summer Housing Timeline:

Summer Session II: Tuition & Housing payment due date

- Check-in Summer II
- Check out Summer II

Monday, June 27, 2022

*Sunday, July 10th from 5pm – 7pm
Wednesday, August 17th by 5:00pm*

Summer Housing Policies:

- Current residents who are returning for Summer Session 1 will be allowed to leave their belongings in their current housing assignment after the residence hall closes for the Spring 2022 semester.
 - *Residents will receive a sign to put on the room door at the end of semester. This sign will indicate to cleaning/maintenance staff to not remove the belongings from the room as the student is returning for Summer Session 1.*
 - *Residents returning for Summer Session 1 will need to completely moved to their assigned summer room within 24-hours of returning on Sunday, May 22nd.*
- Current residents who are returning for either the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 terms will have to move all of their belongings out of their room at the end of the Spring 2022 semester and move into their summer housing assignment upon arrival for either the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 term.
- Residents will need to move out of their summer housing assignment at the end of the summer term unless they are returning for the next consecutive summer term.
 - *Please note: Housing & Residence Life does not offer long-term storage and will not allow students to store items in the Residence Hall Commons unless returning for the next consecutive term or semester.*
- Residents staying until the end of the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 terms will have to completely move-out at the end of the term and will NOT be able to move into their Fall 2022 assigned room until the start of the Fall 2022 semester. This is due to a large group who will be residing in the rest of the Residence Hall Commons/Apartments until close to the start of the Fall 2022 semester. *We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your cooperation!*
- **Residents are responsible for making arrangements to stay off-campus in between each of the summer terms, as these times are not included in your housing contract and summer housing costs.**
 - *Any students who need to remain in housing in between terms, due to extenuating circumstances, will need to speak with a member of the Housing & Residence Life Staff.*
 - *Resident may be charged additional fees for housing outside of the contract period.*

Summer Housing Visitation Policy:

- Visitation hours are from 10:00am-12:00am, Monday through Sunday.
- One overnight guest is permitted on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights only.
- Guests do not have to be signed in, but they must be escorted per the traditional guest policy.
- The main door, back door, and patio doors to the residence hall will only be accessible with a prox card

Other “Need to Know” Summer Housing Info:

- Students are responsible for their own meals and food over the summer.
 - *The Den and Dining Hall are closed and meal plans are not offered during the summer.*
 - *Students can still add FLEX dollars to their accounts at the Bursar’s Office to be used at the College Center Food Court.*
- The Residence Hall Commons Front desk will not be staffed. Residence Life staffing levels will be altered to correspond to the reduced summer population.
- Cleaning, repairs, and renovations are scheduled during the summer months. Summer residents should anticipate some disruptions and inconvenience, including relocation if needed.
- The Health and Wellness Center services will have reduced hours during the summer.
- **Plan accordingly... College Offices will be closed on Fridays starting May 27th – July 8th.**
