

# STAY WITH US THIS SUMMER!

## Summer 2021 Housing Guide

*The Office of Housing & Residence Life is excited to announce we will have housing this summer for Summer Session 1, Summer Session 2, and the Mid-Summer terms!*

### Eligibility:

- *Students must be registered for summer courses in order to be eligible to live in the Residence Hall over the summer. Occupancy will commence and terminate according to the summer session(s) for which you are registered.*
- *Residents must apply for housing by completing a Summer Housing Application online for each term they are registered for and plan to stay on campus.*
- *Residents must make sure their health records in their MyRecordTracker account are current and up-to-date. If any records have expired or will expire over the course of the summer, the student will need to update their records and have it approved by the Health Center prior to moving in.*

**Summer Housing:** Summer Housing will only be offered in the Residence Hall Commons, 1100's wing. Students will only be able to have single rooms due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

### Summer Housing Costs:

- Two rates depending on the length of your summer term
  - Single Room Rate for 6-Week Terms: \$1146.00/session (Summer Session 1, Summer Session 2)
  - Single Room Rate for 10-Week Term: \$1911.00/term (Mid-Summer Term)
- Payment Plan Timelines for Summer Housing Fees & Tuition
  - Apply online via MyNCC by May 1<sup>st</sup> for a three-payment plan (May, June, July)
  - Apply online via MyNCC by June 1<sup>st</sup> for a two-payment plan (June, July)

### Summer Housing Timeline:

- Check out Summer I

*Mid-Summer Session: Tuition & Housing payment due date*

- Check-in Mid-Summer
- Check-out Mid-Summer

*Monday, May 3, 2021*

*Sunday, June 6<sup>th</sup> from 5pm – 7pm*

*Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup> by 5:00pm*

*Summer Session II: Tuition & Housing payment due date*

- Check-in Summer II
- Check out Summer II

*Monday, June 28, 2021*

*Sunday, July 11<sup>th</sup> from 5pm – 7pm*

*Wednesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> by 5:00pm*

### Summer Housing Policies:

- Current residents who are returning for Summer Session 1 will be allowed to leave their belongings in their current Spring 2021 housing assignment after the residence hall closes for the Spring 2021 semester.
  - *Residents will receive a sign to put on the room door at the end of semester. This sign will indicate to cleaning/maintenance staff to not remove the belongings from the room as the student is returning for Summer Session 1.*
  - *Residents returning for Summer Session 1 will need to completely move to their assigned summer room within 24-hours of returning on Sunday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>.*

- Current residents who are returning for either the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 terms will have to move all of their belongings out of their Spring 2021 room at the end of the Spring 2021 semester and move into their summer housing assignment upon arrival for either the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 term.
- Residents will need to move out of their summer housing assignment at the end of the term unless they are returning for the following term.
  - *Please note: Housing & Residence Life does not offer long-term storage and will not allow students to store items in the Residence Hall Commons unless returning for the next consecutive term or semester.*
- Residents staying until the end of the Mid-Summer or Summer Session 2 terms will be able to move their belongings to their Fall 2021 room (if returning).
  - *Residents will need to completely move to their Fall 2021 assigned summer room by the respective end date of their summer term (either August 12<sup>th</sup> for Mid-Summer or August 18<sup>th</sup> for Summer Session 2)*
- Residents are responsible for making arrangements to stay off-campus in between each of the summer terms, as this is not included in the summer housing costs.
  - *Any students who need to remain in housing in between terms, due to extenuating circumstances, will need to speak with a member of the Housing & Residence Life Staff.*
  - *Resident may be charged additional fees for housing outside of the contract period.*

#### **Summer Housing Visitation Policy:**

- Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, visitors or guests will not be permitted in the Residence Hall Commons until further notice.
  - *This policy is being reviewed as pandemic continues to improve. Any changes to this policy will be communicated moving forward.*

#### **Other “Need to Know” Summer Housing Info:**

- Students are responsible for their own meals and food over the summer.
  - *The Den and Dining Hall are closed and meal plans are not offered during the summer.*
  - *Students can still add FLEX dollars to their accounts at the Bursar’s Office to be used at the College Center Food Court.*
    - *The College Center Food Court will be open 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday-Thursday.*
- The Residence Hall front desk will not be staffed. Residence Life staffing levels will be altered to correspond to the reduced summer population.
- Cleaning, repairs, and renovations are scheduled during the summer months. Summer residents should anticipate some disruptions and inconvenience, including relocation if needed.
- The Health and Wellness Center services will have reduced hours during the summer. *More information TBA regarding COVID testing and summer COVID protocols.*
- Plan accordingly... College Offices will be closed on Fridays starting May 28<sup>th</sup> – July 9<sup>th</sup>.
