Break-out Descriptions

Full Day Sessions

OSHA 7100 – Introduction to Machinery and Machine Safeguarding

This course covers the process of identifying, selecting and properly safeguarding machinery to protect employees and others in the work area and deliver appropriate training in safe work practices. Course topics include types of machinery requiring guarding, point of operation, emergency eyewash/shower requirements, hazard communication, OSHA Machinery and Machine Guarding Standards violations, and corrective actions. Upon course completion students will have the ability to explain hazardous actions and motions of various types of machinery, identify methods of safeguarding, and match identified safeguards with the applicable OSHA Machinery and Machine Guarding Standards to reduce and eliminate the potential for accidents and injuries.

Defensive Driving 4 Hour Course – National Safety Council

To provide participants with practical strategies to reduce collision related injuries, fatalities and costly repairs in addition to stressing the importance of attitude in crash prevention while reinforcing good, sensible driving skills that participants already have. Most importantly, it clearly demonstrates the consequences of the poor choices drivers make behind the wheel.

Break-out Session I

Stairways and Ladders-PA Department of Labor & Industry

This program provides an awareness of correct procedures and precautions to take when constructing stairways and using ladders per 29 CFR 1926.1050 in the construction industry.

Flagger Safety- PA Department of Labor & Industry

This program provides an understanding of the training requirements and safe operating methods required for those assigned duties as flaggers in work zones.

Flammable & Combustible Liquids- PA Department of Labor & Industry

This program provides an understanding of the hazards of flammable and combustible liquids in addition to safe storage and handling procedures.

Break-out Session II

Certified Workplace Safety Committee - Member Training- PA Department of Labor & Industry

To introduce all members of Certified Workplace Safety Committees (CWSC) to the requirements for state certification. The purpose of certification is to improve the quality of CWSC to promote the reduction of workplace injuries and illnesses while offering a 5% cost reduction for their employer's workers' compensation insurance premium.

Walking & Working Surfaces- PA Department of Labor & Industry

This program provides information to ensure the safety of walking and working surfaces within a workplace.

Excavations & Trenching- PA Department of Labor & Industry

This program provides information and understanding on the hazards associated with excavations/trenches in addition to what precautions can be taken to ensure the safety of those working in and around.
